

Challenge 8 – Create a fact poster

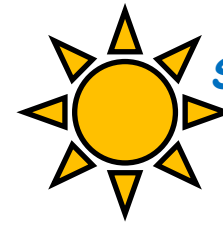
Using the facts you have learnt for challenge 7 make a poster to tell everyone what you know now that you didn't know before!

The poster must be bright, colourful, have pictures that relate to the subject you chose and the facts must be clear and understandable.

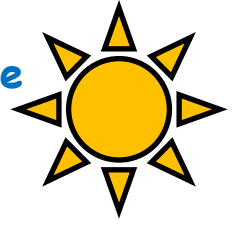
What you need:

- A4 or A3 paper (you can use plain paper or coloured card)
- The title of the subject you are writing about (horses, cars, football, space, ballet... anything!)
- The 3 facts you learnt about that subject.
- Pictures – can be hand drawn or printed from a computer or cut out of a magazine.
- Anything else - Use paints, felt tip pens or pencils, material, glue, sparkles, glitter... go crazy! But don't forget we need to be able to read your 3 facts!

Prove it – hand it in in September to make a lovely Information Book display!

- A library card – don't have one? Sign up for one at the library, its free!

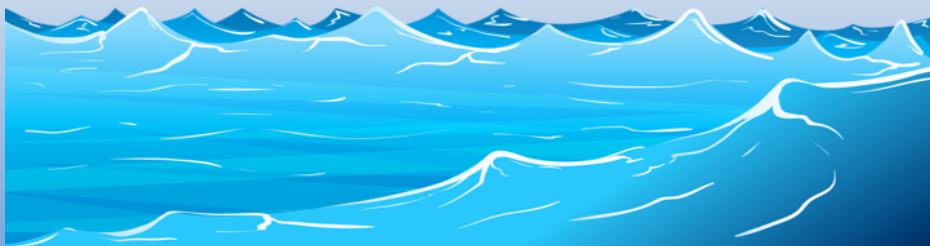
